AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #193 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #193 TO CHANGE THE CITY OF STANDISH PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP COMPOSITION

THE CITY OF STANDISH ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.

SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE #193 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 2.

- A. The City Planning Commission shall consist of seven (7) members and shall consist of the Mayor and City Manager who shall be ex-officed members and five (5) other persons who shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to approval by majority vote of the members elect of the City Council. Said persons shall be representative of important segments of the community, such as the economic, governmental, cducational and social development of the local unit of government, in accordance with the major interests as they exist in the local unit of government, such as but not limited to, agriculture, natural resources, recreation, education, public health, government, transportation, industry, and commerce to the extent practicable.
- B. All members of the Planning Commission may be compensated at a rate to be determined by the City Council. An appointed member shall not hold another municipal office.
- C. The terms of the ex-officio member shall correspond to their official tenures.
- D. The term of each appointed member shall be three (3) years until his or her other successor takes office except that the respective term of one (1) of the members first appointed shall be for one (1) year and two (2) members shall be for two (2) years and two (2) members for three (3) years.
- E. The City Council may remove a member of the Planning Commission for misfeasance, malfeasance, or nonfeasance, in office upon written charges after a public hearing. Before casting a vote on a matter on which a member is reasonably considered to have a conflict of interest, the member shall disclose the potential

conflict of interest to the Planning Commission. The member is disqualified from voting on the matter if so provided by the by-laws or by majority vote of the remaining members of the Planning Commission. Failure of a member to disclose a potential conflict of interest, as required by this section, constitutes malfeasance in office.

SECTION 3.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
